Greetings everyone! Peter Fox here with the November Youth Corner. Fall is here and youth events abound for GUMY and G'jr.

There is so much on our Youth Calendar here at Grace. There are events on pretty much every weekend, and even some during the week. Come out to GUMY and G'jr. this year. We are all about establishing new traditions, strengthening friendships new and old, and becoming one faith family under Christ. Youth events here at Grace are all about faith, fun, and fellowship. And remember, whether in GUMY or G'jr., our youth events are for everyone, and all are celebrated and included! Friends are always welcome.

Here is a brief taste of what we have done so far this season. We have had several awesome GUMY nights this drawing an average of 20 youth at each. At GUMY we have started our "Stir It Up" theme for the year. There are lots of new faces at GUMY, so our youth are doing a great job at spreading the word to their friends. Equally, CURRENT has been good, also, averaging around 20. Youth have been getting into the topics every week, and the discussion is quite lively. I have enjoyed receiving positive comments about both of these programs, and the direction that they are heading. Both G'jr. and HangTime have started off as well. Both have been small numbers-wise, but I hope that they will enjoy a promising future. In G'jr., it is a smaller year for youth who are eligible for G'jr. (we just don't have many in 5th - 6th grade), so they are really going to have to hype it to friends, which I think they will.

With HangTime, it is made a little harder, since it takes place on a weeknight. Youth, now more than ever, are involved in so much outside of church walls. This adds to a busy calendar, which is exactly why HangTime was created. I hope it will grow more as we move forward and youth get used to the night. Well, there you have a synopsis of what we've been doing. Since I still receive some questions about programs, I figured that it cannot hurt to breakdown the programs once more time, to get everyone on the same page: **GUMY** is our Youth Group here at Grace. GUMY is a strong faith family that meets around Christ. GUMY is all about faith, fun, and fellowship. GUMY will be safe space for youth to experience this time together with their peers. In GUMY, lasting friendships will be created, and youth will grow closer to the Lord. GUMY is open to all youth in grades 7 - 12, and friends are always invited and encouraged. Through GUMY, we will strive to create a click-free environment where everyone feels a part of the circle. GUMY meets on most Sunday nights from 5:30 - 8pm. Dinner will be provided.

G'jr. (Pronounced GEE JUNIOR), stands for GUMY Junior and it's for everyone in Grades 5 - 6. G'jr. meets on the first Sunday of every month from 3 - 5pm. All G'jr. events will be geared towards getting youth familiar to the upcoming GUMY experience. We will play crazy GUMY games, learn a little, and have lots of fellowship time together. G'jr. events will take place on a monthly basis on a Sunday, and will be led by myself, parent helpers, and eventually some Sr. High GUMY leaders. Snacks will be provided.

CURRENT is our Sunday School for those in Grades 7 - 12 that meets weekly from 9:30 to 10:30am we will meet in the GUMY Room to focus in on current topics and headlines that surround us every day. We will discuss topics through conversation and media, and filter these through a Christian lens. Moreover, CURRENT is a place for youth and their peers, to get to know one another better, and engage in lively discussion every week. Snacks will be provided.

HangTime is the newest program for GUMY age youth (grades 7 - 12), and it means just that. On the first Wednesday of every month from 6:30 - 8pm GUMY age youth and their friends are welcome to come out to the Youth Group Room to hang out, play games, and just be together. No stress, no pressure; it's a laid-back night to just relax and chill with your peers. Snacks will be provided.
